Holy Cross of Varak Puppets

The cross is hidden . . . then found!

MATERIALS

- Paper cup
- Straw or plastic stick
- Cut out crosses (2 for each student) may be cut out from cardstock, foam, or construction paper
- Glue
- Decorations to make your cup look like a mountain.
 Suggestions: markers, colored construction paper, aluminum foil
- Optional: Small rocks or pebbles



- 1. Make the puppet by gluing the back and front of your cross around the straw, putting them together to seal, (as shown to right using "bunny").
 - Children can decorate the cross, or write on it, "HOLY CROSS OF VARAK"



- 2. Now decorate your paper cup. Decorate using colored markers or construction paper to make it look like a mountain.
- 3. Push the straw through the base of the paper cup to allow it to move up and down and your puppet is finished!
 - *Optional*: Place a few small rocks or pebbles at the bottom of each cup to represent the cross being hidden in the rocks of Mt. Varak.
- 4. Move the puppet cross down (*hidden*) and up (*found*!) Have children re-tell the story of the Holy Cross of Varak as they move their puppets.
