

Angels in the Kitchen

These flying angels will bring happiness and love to your kitchen/dining room while teaching children our mealtime prayer, “*Jash-a-getz-ook.*”

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Flying Angel Template (*to follow*)
- “Jash-a-getzook” Template (*to follow*)
- Cardstock or Construction paper
- Craft sticks
- Yarn
- Scissors
- Crayons
- Glue

PREPARATION BEFORE ACTIVITY

- Make copies of “Jash-a-getzook” Template on cardstock. Cut out. (*Each student needs 1 cross*)
- Make copies of Kitchen Angel Template on cardstock (*1 for each student*) **OR** Using Kitchen Angel Template, cut out angels from construction paper (*4 for each student*)

WHAT TO DO

Step 1. Allow children to color/decorate their 4 Kitchen Angels. Cut out.

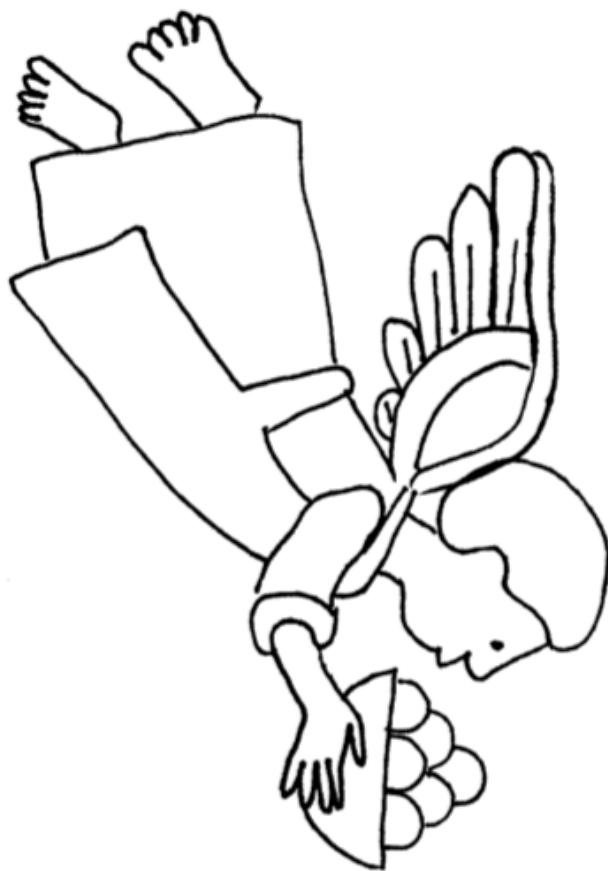
Step 2. With some glue, attach 2 craft sticks together into a cross. Then using yarn, wrap the two craft sticks together, forming a small “God’s Eye” in the center to help secure it.



Step 3. Attach your Kitchen Angels from each end of the craft stick so that they suspend like a mobile. Attach the “Jash-a-getzook” cutout from the center of mobile. Hang in your kitchen or above your dining room table.
