Crafty Spiral Serpent (Construction Paper version)

MATERIALS:


- Colored construction paper
- Printer
- Scissors
- Glue
- Hole punch
- Yarn, string, ribbon
- Scissors
- Wiggly eyes (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Print out template (to follow) and make a copy for each student.
- 2. Allow students to select a piece of colored construction paper and glue template to it.



3. Cut out just the OUTSIDE LINE (outline) of the spiral snake.



- 4. Have student color/design the "coiled" side whatever color they want their snake to be.
- 5. On <u>backside</u>, have students write words and scriptures from the story of Expulsion, (*Adam, Eve, Garden of Eden, Serpent, Fruit, Temptation, Genesis 3:23, etc.*)
- 6. Cut along the spiral line to make a springy spiral snake. (It's ok if you cut through words

on backside)



- 7. Use a hole punch to punch a hole in the center of the snake (the tip of the tail).
- 8. Thread a piece of string through the hole and tie it on.
- 9. Hang your springy spiral snake! And when the snake is "coiled," the Expulsion words may be read.



TEMPLATE: Set page margins to zero if you have trouble fitting the template on the page.
