Crafty Spiral Serpent (Paper Plate version)

MATERIALS:

- Paper plates
- Glue
- Markers
- Red construction paper
- Hole punch
- Yarn, string, ribbon
- Scissors
- Wiggly eyes (optional)



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Decorate: On one side of your paper plate, copy words and/or scriptures from the story of EXPULSION, (Adam, Eve, Garden of Eden, Serpent, Fruit, Temptation, etc.).



2. Decorate: Color/design the other side of your paper plate any way you like.







3. Draw a spiral: Draw a spiral starting on the outside and ending in the center.





4. Cut the spiral: Cut along your spiral until you reach the center. When you're finished cutting you should be able to see the snake you made.





5. Make a tongue: Cut out a small red rectangle from red construction paper or use the pattern at the bottom to look more like a serpent's tongue!



6. Glue the tongue: Glue this piece at the center (head) where the mouth would be and draw eyes.







7. Hang it up: Using hole punch, punch a hole in the center of the head, (trying to avoid the eyes) and tie a piece of yarn.
