Supplies

- Pink Construction Paper or White Paper and Pink Crayons
- Wiggle Eyes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape
- Pig Pattern Template
- Pig Bible Verse Cards Template

Instructions

1. Before class print out the Pig Pattern Template onto pink paper or use white paper and have your children color the patterns pink.
2. Print out the Bible Verse Cards and cut them apart.
3. In class have your children color and cut out the pig and glue the pieces together as shown in picture above.
4. Tape the Bible verse cards to the pig's mouth.
