

The Prodigal's Pig A Stick Puppet

Share the Bible Story, "The Prodigal Son," in Luke 15:11-32. Allow your students to use their Pig Stick Puppets to help act out the story

Supplies:

- Paper plate
- Nut cup
- Scissors
- Glue
- Construction paper (pink, black)
- Craft stick
- Crayons (pink, black,
- Tape (optional)





Instructions:

 Give each student a paper plate. Select a scripture from Luke 15:11-32 and have students copy on the back of plate. For example: And he said to him, 'Son, you are always with

me, and all that is mine is yours. (Luke 15:31)

- 2. Color plate pink.
- 3. Glue the back of the nut cup to the middle of the paper plate for the pig's snout.
- 4. Cut and glue ears onto the top of the paper plate.
- 5. Cut and glue 2 circles for eyes.
- 6. Glue or tape a craft stick to the back of the plate.
- 7. Hold the pig puppet and have students tell the story of the Prodigal Son.

Optional Suggestions:

- 1. Use a pink plate and nut cup to make the puppet.
- 2. Draw in the eyes.
- 3. Tear pieces of pink tissue paper and glue them onto the plate.
- 4. Use a larger plate with a paper cup for the pig's snout.
