12 Disciples Necklace

Jesus picked out 12 helpers to follow Him. They are called Disciples, which means follower. (Apostle means one who is sent.)

Learn the names of all 12 disciples by making a necklace of their names.



SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Printer paper, card stock, or other heavy paper
- "12 Disciples" Template (one for each student)
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- String

PREPARATION BEFORE ACTIVITY

• Print the "12 Disciples" Template onto paper, card stock or other heavy paper. (For younger students, cut out each circle.)

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Give each child a "12 Disciple" Template
- 2. Instruct students to cut out each circle.
- 3. Using hole punch, make a hole at the top of each circle.
- 4. String Disciples through string and tie to make a necklace.

Cut out each Disciple circle. String on a necklace for children to wear

home.
