

Sunday School Craft

Adam and Eve

Sunday of Expulsion Puppets

MATERIALS:

- Paper People Pattern (*to follow*)
- Eve's Hair & Leaf Patterns (*to follow*)
- Light colored construction paper
- Colored markers or crayons
- Scissors
- Craft sticks (or pencils, straws etc.)
- Glue



PREPARATION:

- Print patterns – cut out for younger students
- Make a sample

DIRECTIONS:

1. Give each student:
 - 2 "People" cut outs from the People Pattern that follows (or use pattern and cut out from light colored construction paper)
 - Set of: Eve's Hair (2 pieces), 1 apple, Leaves, 1 Serpent
 - 2 Craft sticks (pencils, straws, chopsticks, etc.)
2. **COLOR:**
 - Eve's Hair pieces – BROWN
 - 1 apple – RED
 - Leaves – GREEN
 - 1 Serpent – ANY COLOR
3. **EVE PUPPET:** Glue the long part of Eve's hair to the back of the puppet's head and then bring the hair that hangs down to the front of the puppet. Glue the bangs to the front of the head.
 - Use colored markers or crayons to draw in her face.
 - Glue apple to her hand.

ADAM PUPPET: Color brown hair on the top of the head.

 - Use colored markers or crayons to draw in his face.
 - Glue serpent to his hand.
4. Glue the leaves on both puppets to cover their private parts.
5. Attach each puppet to a craft stick (pencil, straw, etc.)
6. Have students use the puppets to retell the story of Adam and Eve.
