

Advent/Thanksgiving Turkey Headbands



These faithful Turkeys are arriving just in time for Thanksgiving and the start of Advent.

There are 2 options for making the headbands - **you choose!**

1. Make the feathers in **Thanksgiving** colors (*as pictured*)
2. Make the feathers in **Advent** colors (Green, Blue, Yellow, White, Purple, Red)

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Template
- Colored construction paper: (*Based on if you're making Thanksgiving or Advent headbands*)
 - **For Thanksgiving Turkeys:** Brown, orange, white, black, red, yellow
 - **For Advent Turkeys:** Brown, orange, black, green, blue, yellow, white, red, purple
- Ribbon, yarn, string, or twine
- Glue
- *Optional:* Googly eyes

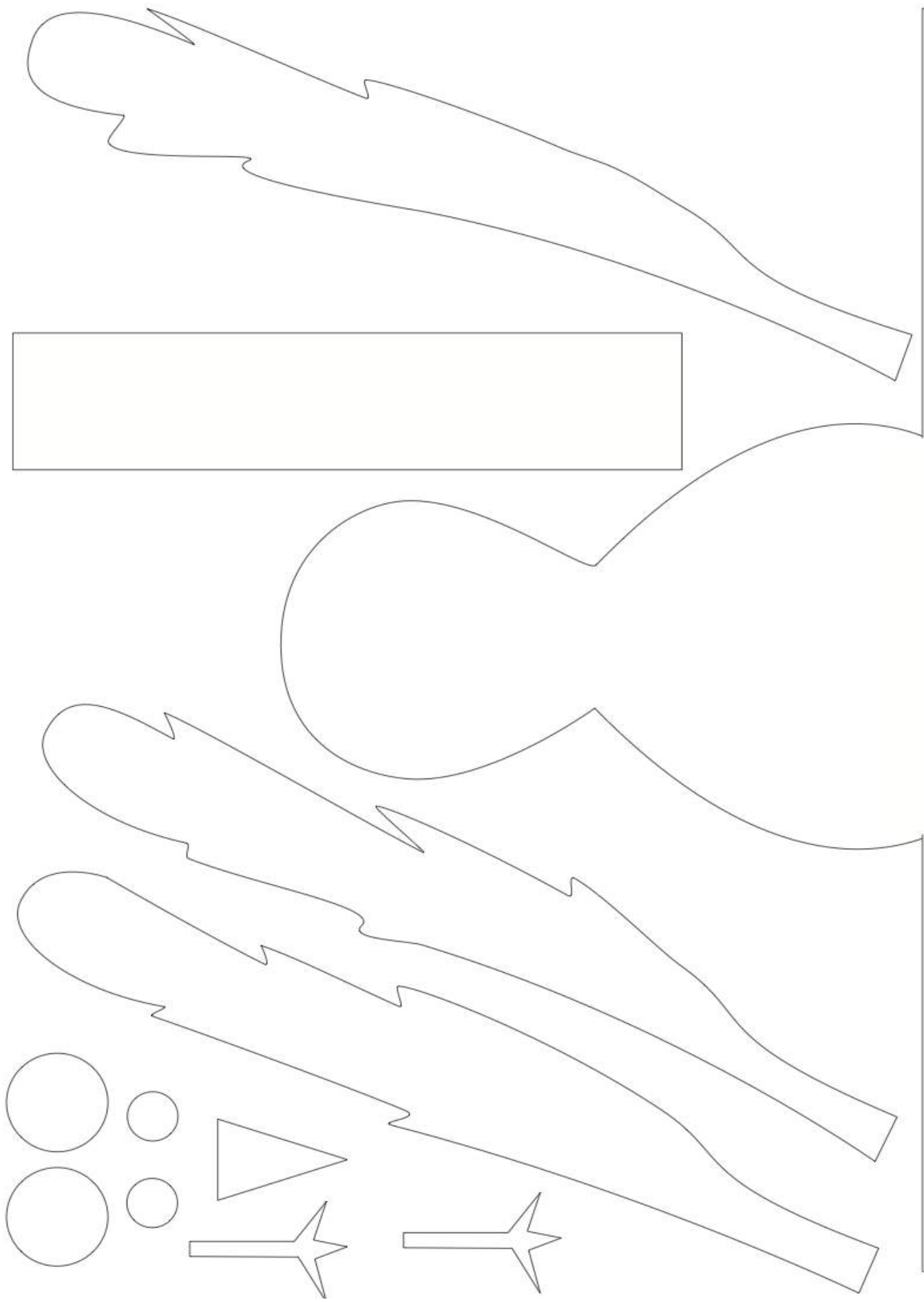
PREPARATION BEFORE ACTIVITY

- Print out Template. Cut out. Trace on construction paper in the colors listed/selected above. Cut out again.
- Make a sample headband for students to copy.

WHAT TO DO

1. Give each child a set of cut out pieces.
2. Turkey Feathers - instruct students to do the following on their feathers:
 - a. **Thanksgiving Turkeys:** On each feather, have students write something they are thankful for (*Optional Template to follow*)
 - b. **Advent Turkeys:** On each colored feather, have them write the meaning of that color during Advent:

Green (Faith)	Blue (Hope)	Yellow (Love)
White (Peace)	Purple (Repentance)	Red (Holy Communion)
3. Instruct students to glue the pieces to create their turkeys by following your sample.
4. Attach some ribbon, twine or string to tie onto child's head.
