Color and Create Craft



Add a prayer list to the blocks, too!

This is a simple “color and fold craft! Just print the page to follow onto stock paper or any other heavy paper, color, cut, and fold! It’s a great craft for the Solemnity of the Annunciation, celebrated in the Armenian Church on April 7.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print a copy of the page to follow for each child.
 2. Color.
Optional: Inside the side blocks,
 - a) add a prayer list (*anyone you want to ask Mary to help and protect*)
 - b) copy Luke 1:30-31
- And the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus.*
3. Cut along the outside edge of the shape.
 4. Fold along the lines marked with the arrows.
 5. Stand it up. Display it on a table or shelf.

Print onto stock/heavy paper. Color. Cut along the outside edge of the shape and fold along the lines marked with the arrows. Stand it up and place it on a shelf or altar.

Feel free to add a prayer list to the blocks in the picture or on the back.
