- Colored construction paper


PREPARATION BEFORE ACTIVITY

- Print Template for each student (to follow)
- Cut construction paper into squares to fit bag

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Start with a brown paper lunch bag. Fold bag in half and rotate it so the opening faces right.
- 2. Cut out Template squares and glue in order so that the pieces read like a story book.
- 3. Using construction paper, have students cut out a "CROSS" and place inside the pocket to use when re-telling the story.





Feast of the Apparition of the Holy Cross






At noon on May 19, 351, a bright and luminous cross appeared over the skies of Jerusalem.
