## SUPPLIES NEEDED

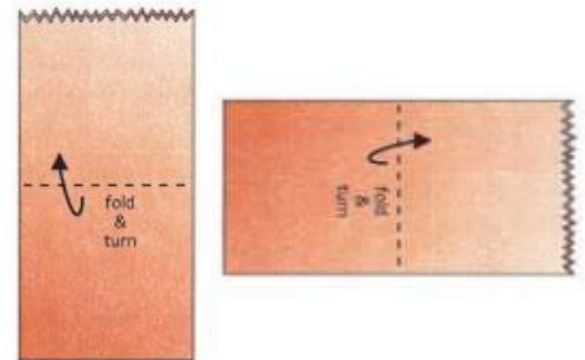
- Brown paper bags
- Scissors

- Glue
- Colored markers, Pens/Pencils
- Colored construction paper

## PREPARATION BEFORE ACTIVITY

- Print Template for each student (to follow)
- Cut construction paper into squares to fit bag

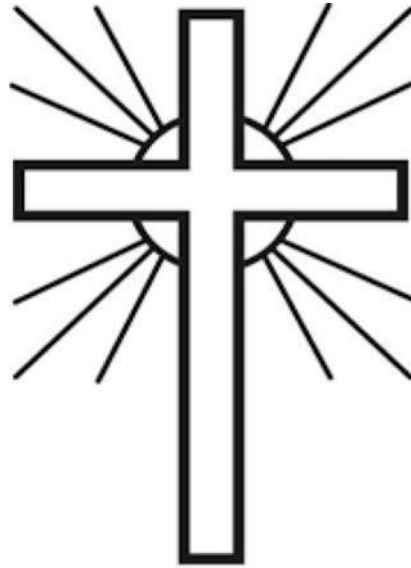
## WHAT TO DO

1. Start with a brown paper lunch bag. Fold bag in half and rotate it so the opening faces right.
2. Cut out Template squares and glue in order so that the pieces read like a story book.
3. Using construction paper, have students cut out a "CROSS" and place inside the pocket to use when re-telling the story.

# Feast of the Apparition of the Holy Cross

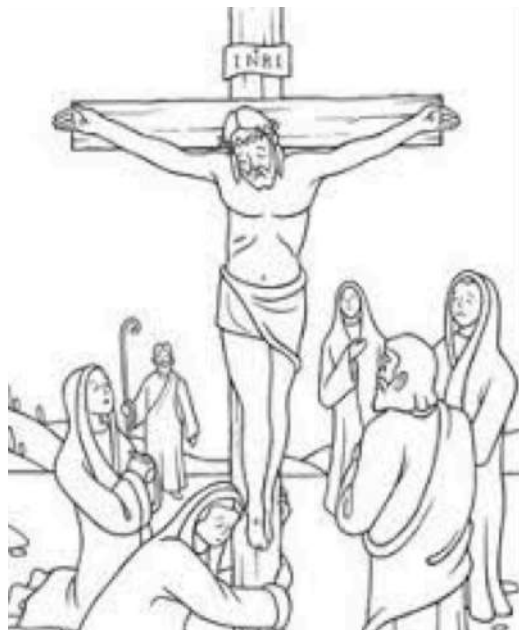
