

Sunday School Craft

Armor of God BELT OF TRUTH

SCRIPTURES:

Ephesians 6:10-11 “ Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.”

Ephesians 6:14 “Stand therefore, and fasten the belt of truth around your waist, . . .”



MATERIALS:

- Ribbon or String
- Belt Template (use as a pattern OR cut out several using colored construction paper – each child will need 4.)
- Colored construction paper
- Stapler
- Scissors



PREPARATION:

- Print Template(s)
- Cut out pieces of Belt Template for younger students.

Ephesians teaches us to be strong in the Lord and in His great power. We are asked to wear God's full armor so that we can fight against the devil's evil tricks.

The Belt of Truth is an important piece of the armor of God. Copy the phrases below onto your belt pieces to be reminded of how God asks that we are always truthful.

- Be strong in the LORD!
- Put on the whole armor of God!
- Belt of Truth
- Fight against evil!

DIRECTIONS:

1. Print out Belt Template and use as a pattern to cut out several belt pieces using colored construction paper. Each child will need 4.
OR make a copy of the template for each student with words already printed on belt pieces. Cut out.
2. Give each student 4 of the construction paper belt pieces (or template pieces).
3. Have students copy each Belt of Truth phrase (above) onto 1 of their belt pieces.
4. Cut a piece of sturdy ribbon or string, long enough to be tied around the child's waist.
5. Staple the top of each belt piece onto the center of the ribbon. (This works best if you fold the top of the belt piece over the string and staple.)
6. Tie belt around student's waist.
