Church Banner (Khachvar)


Banners (*Khachvar*) are used to lead processions when there is a festive occasion in the Armenian Church. At the tip of its staff there is a small cross and below it, ornamented fabric, usually of needlework.


MATERIALS:

- Wire clothes hangers (from dry cleaners) 1 for each student
- Large colored construction paper (12x17)
- Colored markers or crayons
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Banner Template

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Give each student a large piece of colored construction paper. Fold in $\frac{1}{2}$ lengthwise.
- 2. Instruct them to TRACE the Banner Template onto their construction paper along the fold as shown to the right.
- 3. <u>Keeping paper folded</u>, cut out. (Your banner should now open up so that you can drape over the bottom of a hanger.)
- 4. Keeping paper folded, instruct students to decorate using markers or crayons:
 - On 1 side: Write, "Khachvar"
 - On the other side: Draw a symbol of an item we SEE on the altar, such as
 - o 12 candles
 - o Gospel
 - o Chalice
 - o Flowers
- 5. Drape the fold of the banner over the bottom of the hanger and glue together.
- 6. Using construction paper scraps, cut out a CROSS and attach to the top of hanger.
