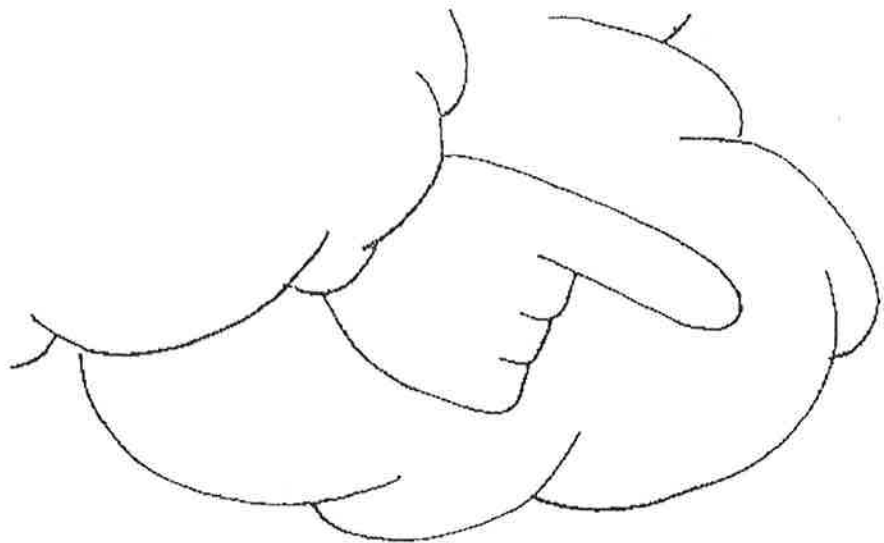


A serpent lived in the Garden. He was jealous of Adam and Eve because God loved them so much. He decided to try to trick them into eating the forbidden fruit from the special tree.
