Sunday School Craft

Sacrament #4: Marriage (Holy Matrimony)

SCRIPTURE:

Read: John 2:1-11

The Steward tasted the water that had become wine

MATERIALS:

- Brown construction paper
- Tissue Paper: Light blue or White (to represent water) AND Red or Purple (to represent wine)
- Glue sticks
- Scissors
- Colored pencils
- Stapler or tape

PREPARATION:

- Cut brown construction paper into pieces 6" x 4 ½"
- Cut brown construction paper into 1-inch strips
- Print Water and Wine labels (to follow) and cut out

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Roll a sheet of brown construction paper up and staple/tape together to make a tube, (like a toilet paper roll).
- 2. Cut out a strip of brown construction paper to make a "handle" and attach to side of tube.
- 3. Cut the tissue paper into 6-inch squares. Each student needs 1 piece of light blue or white tissue and 1 piece of red or purple tissue.
- 4. Crinkle the light blue/white tissue and push into one end of the tube. Turn tube over, crinkle the red/purple tissue and push into the other end of the tube.
- 5. Give each student a "Water" label and a "Wine" label. Color.
- 6. With the LIGHT BLUE/WHITE tissue facing up, attach the "water" label to one side of the tube.
- 7. Turn tube over with the RED/PURPLE tissue facing up, attach the "wine" label to the other side of the tube. (Make sure that when the light blue/white tissue paper is on tope, the "water" label is readable and when the red tissue is on top the "wine" label is readable.)
