<p>This commemorates the Jewish Festival of Freedom — the Jews recall how the blood of a lamb saved them from death.</p>	<p>Jesus frees men from sin by becoming the sacrificial Lamb of God, by shedding his blood, and by his death on the cross.</p>	<p>The Christian community participates in the sacrifice and reenacts the events of the Last Supper. We give ourselves wholeheartedly to God.</p>
<p>At the Passover Feast, Jewish families give thanks to God for his love and protection over the Israelites as God guided them from slavery to freedom.</p>		
<p>Unleavened bread is broken and given to the family members to be eaten.</p>		
<p>Wine is traditionally a part of the Passover meal. The cup is raised and the people give thanks for all their blessings.</p>		
<p>The entire Jewish family shares in the sacrificial meal of Thanksgiving.</p>
