A "Po-It-Yourself" Guide to put together your own Advent Workshop

The Advent Season in the Armenian Church is one of significance and tradition. This guide is designed for superintendents/teachers to organize an workshop for students to celebrate the Advent season. Your workshop may include as many of our activities provided or select some of your own! It is my hope that your Advent Workshop will be enjoyable and lead to wonderful discussions about this special time of the year.

PREPARATION:

- Advertise! Post flyers around your church parish, email to parents, and put in your church bulletin
- Select a facility (such as the Ararat Home, etc.) for the children to visit and present Advent gifts
- Recruit lots of volunteers to help supervise your activity stations
- Find someone to help lead children in singing songs
- Invite clergy to provide a devotional service and participate in the day
- Start gathering all supplies & materials that you will need early
- A few items you may want to have on hand:
 - Hand wipes
 - Disposable table cloths

SAMPLE SCHEDULE (for Workshop at Ararat Home in So. Calif.):

10:00 - 10:45am Chapel or Devotional Service

Arrange for children to sing 1 or 2 "sharagans" during the service

10:45 - 11:15am Welcome + Explanation of Workshop theme (to follow)

Explanation of the day's schedule plus preview of activities

Practice songs that student will sing for residents

Begin Workshop activities

11:15 - 11:45am Visit & sing for Nursing Home facility

Songs led by Sevag Derderian, (AACCWD)

11:45 - 12:30pm Continue Workshop activities

12:30 - 1:00pm Lunch

1:00 - 2:00pm Priest's Demonstration - Let's Make "Mahs!"

Coordinating activity where students will follow along and make their own "mahs"

2:00 - 2:15pm Visit & sing for Assisted Living facility

2:15pm Dismissal
