# **IDEAS TO GET PARENTS INVOLVED**

In our Sundays schools and their children's faith formation

- 1. Organize a Sunday school Board or Committee (Different Board positions include: Chair, Vice Chair, Treasurer, Photographer/Historian, Hospitality, Advisors)
- 2. Invite parents to take turns sharing during Assembly
  - Have sign ups for each Sunday
  - Can be a lesson, experience, first church memory give a list of ideas
- 3. Invite parents to teach a mini lesson one Sunday and/or volunteer and assist in classroom (or make this mandatory?)
  - Something cultural
  - Something religious based
  - Share a story
  - Share a talent (musical, artistic, etc.)
- 4. Ask parents to help with a special event
- 5. Hold parent meetings 2 times a year while children are in class. Make this mandatory! (Remember to always create a sign up sheet for tasks needed at that time.)
- 6. Volunteer to bring snacks on Sunday
- 7. Generate a list of your activities for the school year and ways they can help (people in general get more involved when they are assigned specific tasks.)
- 8. Organize a Classroom/School cleanup day include the children!
- 9. Plan a field trip to your church neighbor. Remember them throughout the school year:
  - Sept. 28 National Good Neighbor Day
  - Christmas Christmas caroling; send Christmas cards; have children make handmade wreaths
  - April Make Armenian flags in memory of genocide with labels
  - May 1 May Day! Secretly leave flowers by your neighbors' door(s)
- 10. Plan a FAMILY Field Trip or other Activity
- 11. Lead a service project with kids to volunteer or collect donations for a specific cause
- 12. Encourage attendance by using incentive charts
- 13. Make a "Bag of Virtues" that will be sent home each Sunday with a different student to bring back the next Sunday. Include:
  - A list of Virtues
  - Journal (Write name + 1 good deed performed that week
  - Optional: bring treat to distribute
- 14. Organize a fundraiser
- 15. Know what your parents do for a living!
- 16. "Yes Hye Em" poster do together at home


# BAG of VIRTUES Prudence Justice Temperance Courage Faith Hope Charity
