Fighting the Good Fight Gloves



1 Timothy 1:18

Fight the

Good Fight

SCRIPTURES:

1 Timothy 1:18 *"I am giving you these instructions, Timothy, my child, in accordance with the prophecies made earlier about you, so that by following them you may fight the good fight,"*

MATERIALS:

- Plastic (disposable) gloves
- Sharpie markers
- String or ribbon
- "Godly person" Template for younger students (to follow)
- Scissors

PREPARATION:

- Print Template (for younger students) cut out.
- Make a sample practice blowing up a glove and tying with string/ribbon

DIRECTIONS:

ASK: "What does it mean to "Fight the Good Fight?" How does a "godly person" act towards others? (Loving, kind, helpful, etc.)

- 1. Give each student 2 plastic gloves. Lay flat on desk/table.
- 2. Using a Sharpie marker, on the front of 1 glove, write, "Fight the Good Fight" On the front of the other glove, write, "1 Timothy 1:18"
- 3. **OLDER STUDENTS**: Using a Sharpie marker, on each finger, write 1 word that describes a "godly person." **YOUNGER STUDENTS**: Give each student a set of "Godly person" squares, (*template to*

follow). Cut out and discuss each square. Place inside plastic gloves.

- 4. <u>Gently</u> and <u>slowly</u>, blow up gloves like a balloon. (If you blow too hard or fill with too much air, the glove will pop!) Tie with string or ribbon.
- 5. Tie 2 gloves together.

DIRECTIONS: Cut into rows. Give each student a row. Students fill in the last box with their own "Godly person" description and picture.
