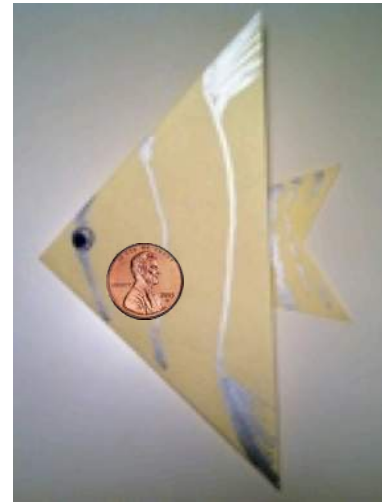


FISH WITH THE COIN ORIGAMI

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 17:24-27

MATERIALS:

- Paper
- Pennies (1 for each student)
- Colored markers or crayons
- Scissors
- Glue or clear scotch tape



DIRECTIONS:

Step 1: Start with a square piece of paper. (If you only have regular 8.5x11 paper, fold it into a triangle and cut off the extra portion.)



Step 2: Fold the upper left corner to the lower right corner, then unfold.



Step 3: Fold the upper right corner to the lower left corner, then unfold.



Step 4: Fold the top half back, then unfold.



Step 5: Poke the center with your finger so that the center pops in.



Step 6: Bring the left and right sides together so that the paper collapses into a triangle.



Step 7: Rotate the triangle left 90° (counter-clockwise).



Step 8: Fold the bottom corner up a little above the center as shown.



Step 9: Fold the top flap over the bottom one as shown.



Step 10: Turn the fish over, Draw the eye and some stripes to make it look nice. Attach a coin (penny) to the fish using glue or scotch tape.
Optional: Have students copy all or part of Matthew 17:24-27
