Book of Mark FOLLOWING IN HIS FOOTSTEPS

SCRIPTURE: Mark 3:14 And he appointed twelve, whom he also named apostles, to be with Him, and to be sent out to proclaim the message,

ACTIVITY 1

MATERIALS:

- Construction paper
- Pencils/pens
- Scissors



- 1. Give each student a piece of construction paper. Have student put their foot/shoe in the middle of the paper and trace around it. Cut out.
- 2. At the top of the footprint, have students copy Mark 3:14.
- 3. In the center of the cut out foot/shoe, have student write/draw what it means to be a "Disciple of God." Continue to decorate as you wish.
- 4. Attach the footprints onto your classroom floor so students will remember each time they enter the room to "walk with God" as a Disciple of Christ!

ACTIVITY 2

MATERIALS:

Colored chalk

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Take students outside of the classroom and find an area of sidewalk where students can draw using chalk. (Someplace where other parishioners walk past would be perfect!)
- 2. Before beginning, draw a very large heart someplace on the sidewalk. Copy Mark 3:14 inside the heart.
- 3. Give each student a piece of chalk. Using the chalk, have student trace their footprints inside of the heart.
- 4. Once you have all footprints, write around the outside of the heart: "We are all Disciples of God!"
