

Paper Bag Superhero: God Chooses Joshua


Superhero Joshua!

MATERIALS:

- Mask Printable (*next page*)
- Colored Markers or Paint & Paint brushes
- Sharpie Markers
- Construction paper (*cut into triangles to make a cape*)
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Glue
- **Optional** – other desired embellishments like glitter, feathers, sequins etc.



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print and trim out the mask printable (*next page*).
2. Have children glue their mask to the “flap” (bottom) of the bag.
3. Have children draw eyeballs in the middle of the mask and a mouth underneath.
4. Have children copy the  (*for Joshua*) in the center of the bag, as pictured. You may like to draw this at the front of room so they may copy.
5. Give each student a piece of colored construction paper to cut out a triangle as a cape.
6. Allow children to decorate their paper bag however they like.
7. Be sure to cut out a cape for your superhero out of construction paper. Attach to back.
8. On the back cape, children may copy words and phrases about our Bible lesson, like:
 - Courage
 - God Chooses Joshua
 - Super Joshua
 - **Joshua 1:9** *"This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."*
