"Good Works" Glasses

SCRIPTURES:

"Remind them to . . . be obedient, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show every courtesy to everyone.

Titus 3:1-2

MATERIALS:

- Card Stock (or Construction paper)
- Glasses Template (to follow)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Stapler
- Colored Markers
- Decorate items, such as stickers, gems, glitter, etc.

PREPARATION:

- Print Template – cut out for younger students
- Make a sample

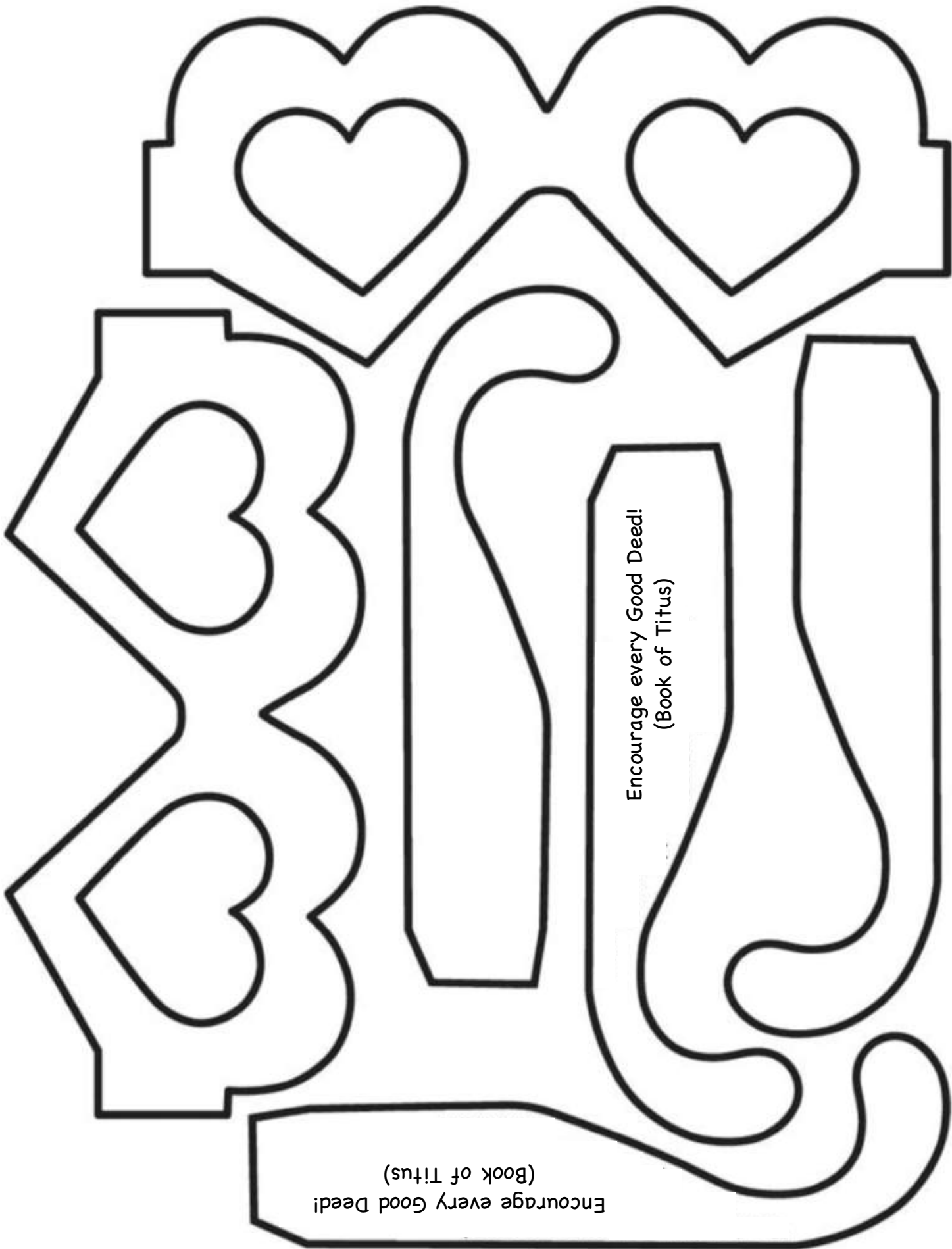
DIRECTIONS:

1. Before class, print out the Glasses pattern (to follow). You can either print on Card Stock, OR print on regular paper, but glue copies to construction paper before cutting out to make the glasses stronger.
2. Give each student a glasses pattern (from Template).
3. In class fold back the edges of the earpieces to fit each child. Staple or glue them to the eyepieces.
4. Have students decorate the glasses with colored markers, stickers, glitter glue, gems, etc.
