- If Luke was a tax collector, cross out box C-3. If he was not, cross out box C-5. (Colossians 4:14).
- In Mark 10:17-25, what did the young man have to do before he could enter the Kingdom of Heaven? If it was to become an apostle of Jesus, cross out box E-4. If it was to give up his love of riches, cross out box E-2.
- If Lazarus is the brother of Mary and Martha, cross out box G-1. If he is not, cross out box G-2. (John 11:1-4)
- If Mary Magdalene was the first person to see Jesus after he rose from the dead, cross out box B-5. If she was not, cross out box B-3. (John 20:11-18)

- If Barabbas was released in Jesus' place, cross out box F-4. If he was not, cross out box F-5. (Mark 15:6-15)
