HOLY BIBLE BOOK COVERS

Every important book must be protected. There is no book more important than the Holy Bible, God's Word. Let's design a book cover for the Bible. Include the Books of the Bible on the back for reference!

Supplies:

- Large construction paper (12 x 18 size) white or a light-color works best
- Colored markers

Step 1: Place construction paper horizontally on the table. Step 2: Fold at the top and the bottom.


Make a fold about 2-inches from the top paper of the paper and another fold the same size from the bottom of the paper.

Step 3: Fold at the sides.

Make a fold about 2-inches at the left side of the paper and another fold the same size at the right side of the paper.

Step 4: Fold slightly off-center to create the book's binding.

Keeping everything folded, bring the left size of paper over to the right leaving about an inch from the edge and make a crease. Unfold. Now do the same by bringing the right side of the paper over the left and leaving an inch from the edge and make a crease. Once you have made these 2 creases, your book cover will have a binding, (where the Title may be written).



Step 5: Design your book's FRONT Cover, (pic. above).

• Cover title to read, "BIBLE" (both on the front as well as on the side binding)

Step 6: Design your book's BACK Cover (pic. to right).

• Have students copy the Books of the Old and New Testament on the back (or make copies of page 2 and students can cut/paste these on the back.)

When finished, display students' Book Covers on your classroom wall, or have them keep at their desks to use for reference when looking up scripture during the school year.
