

Sunday School Craft

How Would You Change the World?

SCRIPTURES:

Let no one despise your youth, but set the believers an example in speech and conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.
(1 Timothy 4:12)

MATERIALS:

- Paper plates (or white construction paper cut into circles)
- White paper (construction paper would work best, but any white paper will work)
- Blue and green colored markers or crayons
- Glue
- Scissors

PREPARATION:

- Make a sample

DIRECTIONS:

ASK: *“How would GOD want you to change the world? (Each student’s response will be written on their handprint.)”*

1. Using a piece of white paper, trace each student’s handprint. Cut out. In the center write student’s response to, *“How would GOD want you to change the world?”*
2. Give each student a white paper plate (or white construction paper circle). Have student color plate with Blue and Green colored markers or crayons to resemble a map/globe, (see picture above) – it’s ok if some of the white background is visible.
3. Glue handprint cutout to center of the plate.
