

“Jash-a-getz-ook” Placemats (Armenian Prayer Before Mealtime)



Your students can use these simple placemats at home to continue to learn the Armenian prayer before mealtime. Allow students to make a placemat for each of their family members and instruct them to set tonight’s dinner table with them and lead the mealtime prayer.

Teach students the “Jash-a-getz-ooz,” (Armenian Prayer before mealtime), in Armenian and English, by reciting and repeating:

ARMENIAN:

Jashagestsook khaghaghootyamp ezgeragoores,
vor badrasdyal eh mez ee Dyarneh.
Orhnyal eh Der ee barkeves yoor.
Amen.

ENGLISH TRANSLATION:

In peace let us eat this food which the
Lord has provided for us.
Blessed be the Lord in His gifts.
Amen.

Materials:

- Colored construction paper (12x18 size) OR Paper placemats (can be found at Smart & Final)
- Colored markers, crayons, or Paint (*NOTE: If using paint, you will also need Paintbrushes*)
- Glue sticks
- Templates (to follow)

Directions:

1. Print a copy of Template for each student.
2. Have students each select a piece of colored construction paper (or paper placemat) and decorate using markers, crayons, or paint.
3. Glue Prayer Template to the middle of construction paper.
