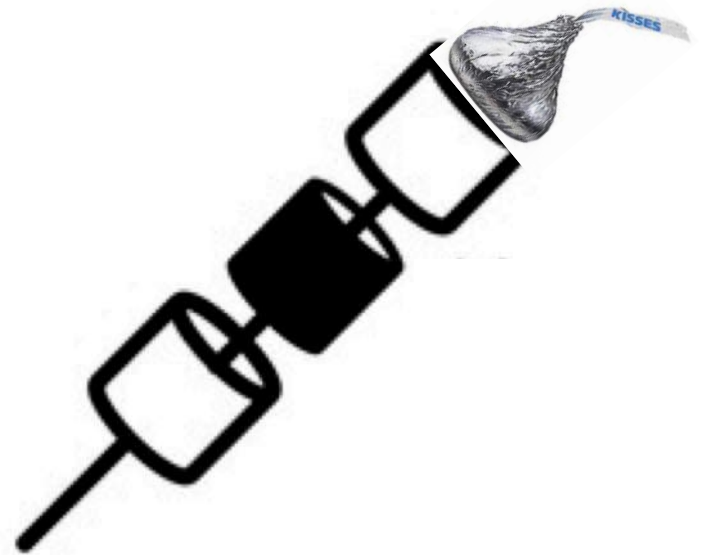


Marshmallow Candle Kabobs

These tasty Marshmallow Candle Kabobs are a fun way to reinforce the significance of 12 candles on the Armenian altar.

Supplies:

- Mini Marshmallows (12 for each child)
Or 3 Large Marshmallows (younger children)
- Hershey's kisses (wrapped)
- Toothpicks
- Thin, long "Kebab" Sticks



Instructions:

1. Use 12 mini marshmallows for each candle kebab, *(to represent the 12 candles that appear on the Armenian altar, 1 for each disciple of Christ)* **OR** 3 Large marshmallows *(to represent the Holy Trinity)*.
2. Start by carefully attaching a (wrapped) Hershey's kiss at the tip of one end of the kebab stick, just enough to stay in place but no need to push all the way through. Keep the kiss wrapped in its shiny paper to look like the flame.
3. Using a toothpick, have students poke a hole down the center of each of their 12 mini marshmallows. (This will make it easier to put marshmallows onto the long "kebab" stick.)
4. Beginning at the end opposite the kiss, have students place marshmallows onto long "kebab" stick, so that they go all the way up to the bottom of the kiss. Continue until all 12 marshmallows are attached.
5. *Optional:* Place in a Ziploc or cellophane bag and tie with ribbon so students may take home.
