## Book of Matthew MUSTARD SEED FLOWER

**SCRIPTURE:** Matthew 13:31-32

He put before them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that someone took and sowed in his field; 32 it is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the greatest of shrubs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and make nests in its branches."

## **MATERIALS:**

- Mustard Seeds (enough for each child to have a few)
- Small paper plates (dessert size)
- Yellow colored paint or markers
- Black paper, cut into circles for center of flower
- Craft sticks
- Green paper
- Scissors
- Liquid Glue
- Clear tape (optional)

## **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Give each student a paper plate. Color the plate yellow.
- 2. Glue a black paper circle to the center.
- 3. Cut small slits into the parameter of paper plates, leaving a small space between each slit. (You will almost be cutting out small triangles to make slits.) These will make your flower petals. (See picture to right.)
- 4. Paint or color craft stick green. Glue/attach craft stick to the back of the paper plate as the stem.
- 5. Cut two leaves from the green paper and glue to either side of the craft stick.
- 6. Put a circle of liquid glue in the center of the flower (on the black paper) and sprinkle a few mustard seeds inside the glue. Allow to dry. OR, if using clear tape, sprinkle a few mustard seeds in the center of the flower and cover with a piece of
  - clear scotch tape.
- 7. On the back of the flower, copy: Matthew 13:31-32
