SCRIPTURE:

Luke 2:12

And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger.”

MATERIALS:

- Template (to follow)
- Pens, pencils, colored pencils, crayons

PREPARATION:

- Print out copies of Template – each student needs 1 copy

DIRECTIONS:

1. Give each student a copy of the Template, (to follow).
2. Instruct each student to write inside each square something they can do during Advent to represent their love for Jesus. This can be an act of kindness, something reflective, something to refrain from, etc. You may brainstorm with students some ideas before they begin to write. (Say a special mealtime prayer tonight; Make a “secret” Christmas card for someone; No video games today . . .)
3. Allow students to decorate as they wish.
4. Students will follow their Advent Calendars beginning today until Armenian Christmas, January 6.
