Sunday School Craft "KEJOICE!" In the New Year Paper Pinata

SCRIPTURE: PHILIPPIANS 4:4 "Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice!"

MATERIALS:

- Large Brown Grocery Bag (do as a class or bring enough bags to work in small groups))s
- Colored markers or crayons
- Curly Ribbon
- Paper cut into small (3-inch) squares
- String
- Scissors
- Markers
- Glue
- Stapler
- Goodies to put in the Pinata

PREPARATION:

- Print Pattern (to follow)
- Cut paper into squares (approx. 3 inches)
- On several paper squares, write: "REJOICE!"



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. SIDE 1: In the center of one side of your large grocery bag, write the word "**REJOICE**" in large letters. Allow each student to continue helping you decorate this side of the bag with pictures and words that represent things that give them JOY and reason to REJOICE.
- 2. SIDE 2: Print out the "Rejoice in the Lord!" pattern (next page), cut out, and glue to the other side of bag.
- 3. Tape colored ribbons to the top of the bag so that they hang down.
- 4. Give each student a small square piece of paper. Instruct them to write/draw something that gives them JOY. Place all paper squares (including the squares that you prepared earlier) inside the bag.
- 5. Continue to fill the bag with other goodies.
- 6. Tie or staple the top of the bag closed. Punch a hole in the top and attach a string to the bag through the hole so that the piñata can be hung up.
- 7. "Break" the pinata (safely!) with children either at the end of class, or next Sunday in the New Year!
