

NOAH'S ARK GAMES

PIN ANIMAL ON THE ARK: This will be played like "pin the tail on the donkey" but the teacher will cut out a large ARK and place it on the wall. Give each student an ANIMAL STICKER or cut out animals from a magazine, or let children make/draw an animal on a piece of construction paper and cut out. Children will be blindfolded and will take turns pinning an animal on the ark on the wall.

RAINBOW DROPS: This will be played like "pin the tail on the donkey" but the teacher will cut out a RAINBOW and place it on the wall. Children will be blindfolded and will take turns pinning a cut out rain DROP onto the rainbow. The teacher can give points for the raindrops pinned on each color -- such as the red could be 10 points, the blue could be 20 points, the yellow could be 5 points, etc.

RAINBOW ARCH HUNT: The teacher will make a large curved rainbow and cut out each of the colored arches. (You will want to have at least one curved arch for each child to find.) The curved and colored arches will then be hidden around a designated area. The children can each go to hunt for one rainbow arch and bring it back to their desk. Instruct children to copy today's Bible theme onto their arch: "GOD KEEPS HIS PROMISES TO THOSE WHO OBEY. Then have children bring their arch to the front of the classroom and tape together to form a rainbow.
