Sunday School Craft PAPER HANDCUFFS

Break the Chain with Forgiveness!

SCRIPTURES:

"no longer as a slave but more than a slave, a beloved brother -" Philemon 16

MATERIALS:

- Colored Construction paper
- Rubber bands (large enough to go around students' wrists)
- Scissors
- · Glue, tape or staple



- Cut strips from colored construction paper
- Make a sample

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Each student will need:
 - 2 rubber bands
 - 6 strips of construction paper, cut roughly 1 inch wide by 5 inches long. (Strips may be pre-cut for younger students; older students may like to cut their own strips.)
- 2. Begin with 1 rubber band and 1 strip of construction paper. Loop the construction paper strip through the rubber band and secure with glue or staple.
- 3. Loop another strip of construction paper through the first construction paper strip. Continue until you have <u>5</u> paper links attached to each other.
- 4. Take the 2nd rubber band and the 6th construction paper strip. Loop the 6th construction paper strip through BOTH the 2nd rubber band and the last construction paper link, forming one strand with rubber bands at each end.







5. Attach rubber bands to students' wrists being careful not to pull.
