2 PROPHET GROUP ACTIVITIES "In the Potter's Hands"

Yet, O LORD, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand. Isaiah 64:8

GAME ACTIVITY #1: CLAY BALL ROLLING

Before class time, the teacher can form a clay ball and allow to dry completely. Children can divide into



teams and do a game of "bowling" with the clay ball and try rolling the clay ball to hit a "target" or get closest to an object (like shuffleboard).

GAME ACTIVITY #2: POTTER RELAY

Before class, cutout 2 identical "Paper People." Cut into 6 body parts, as pictured below. Divide students into two teams. Each team will have the same body parts in a pile on the table at the other side of the room. Each team will need a wall to tape the body parts on the wall, as well as masking or clear tape. When the teacher says, GO, the first child will run to the table and find the head and tape to the wall. That child will run quickly back to the team and the next team player will run up to the table and find the body and tape to the head on the wall; the next player can find one arm and tape to the wall; the next player finds the second arm; then each of the legs. The winning team are the "potters" who get their body together first. The children will enjoy seeing their body together at the end of the game. OPTIONAL: Have teams color/decorate their person however they wish, beginning with making a "heart" on the chest and copying the above scripture from *Isaiah 64:8* inside.
