Pumpkin Prayer Craft



What You Need

- White paper plates
- Orange crayons
- Black Sharpie Markers OR Black Construction Paper OR Copies of facial pieces from template (to follow)
- Green Construction Paper, cut in quarters
- Scissors
- Glue
- Templates: Pumpkin Prayer Bookmark (separate attachment)

Preparation before Activity

- If using Template:
 - Make 1 copy for each child OR
 - Use as a pattern and cutout a set of pieces for each child using black construction paper.
- Print out and cut apart Bookmarks

What To Do

- 1. Read aloud to students "The Pumpkin Prayer." Check for understanding.
- 2. Give each child a paper plate. Instruct them to color the plate orange.
- 3. Give each child a set of facial pieces either from template or cutout from black construction paper **OR** students may DRAW the facial shapes onto their plate.
- 4. Slowly, read The Pumpkin Prayer again aloud stopping so that as you are reading, students can glue/draw pieces onto paper plate to create a jack o'lantern face.
- 5. Give each child a ¼ sheet of green construction paper. Let students design and cutout their own stem. Glue to top of plate.
- 6. Glue a copy of the Pumpkin Prayer Bookmark on the back.
