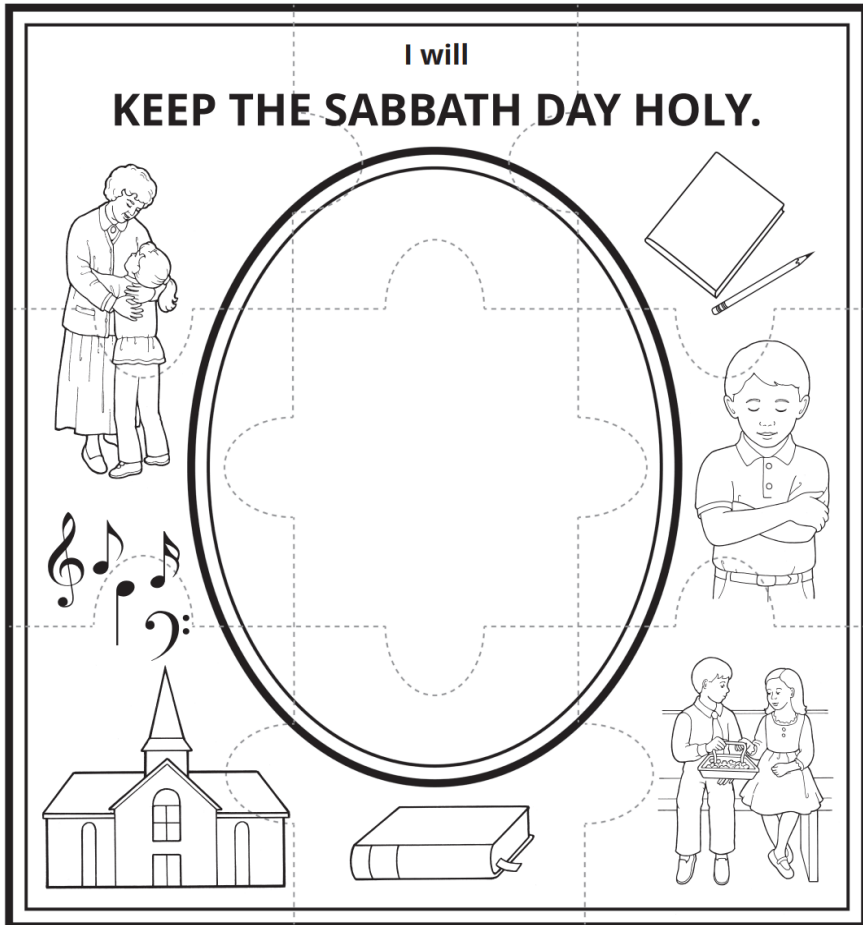


THE SABBATH

KEEPING ONE DAY HOLY

Third Sunday after Pentecost | Matthew 12:1-8

In Christ's time, Saturday, also known as the Sabbath was a holy day dedicated only to God. It was a day that God commanded His people to rest, that is, not to work but to dedicate to Him. Sabbath means "rest" in Hebrew. This is also where we get our Armenian word shabat (շաբաթ), for Saturday.

In the Gospel reading, the Pharisees are upset with Jesus because His disciples are eating grains because they're hungry. The Pharisees viewed this as work and so they accuse Jesus and His disciples of breaking God's word of keeping the Sabbath holy. Jesus however tells them that He is the God of Sabbath, that is to say, He is the one who created the Sabbath.

Today our holy day for the Lord is Sunday. In fact, the Armenian word for Sunday is geer-a-gee (կիրակի) which means "of the Lord," implying that this day belongs to Him.

As Christians, this does not mean that we only worship God on Sundays, but instead we dedicate this day to him Because this is the day that he resurrected from the dead. We remember how He defeated death, sin and Satan and has granted us the ability to have eternal life, through participating in the sacraments of the Church.

On Sundays, what do you and your family do that shows God that you are thinking and worshipping Him?

Do you attend Church, read the Bible, pray, and/or help other people in need?

Or do you sleep in, watch TV, and ignore God on His day?

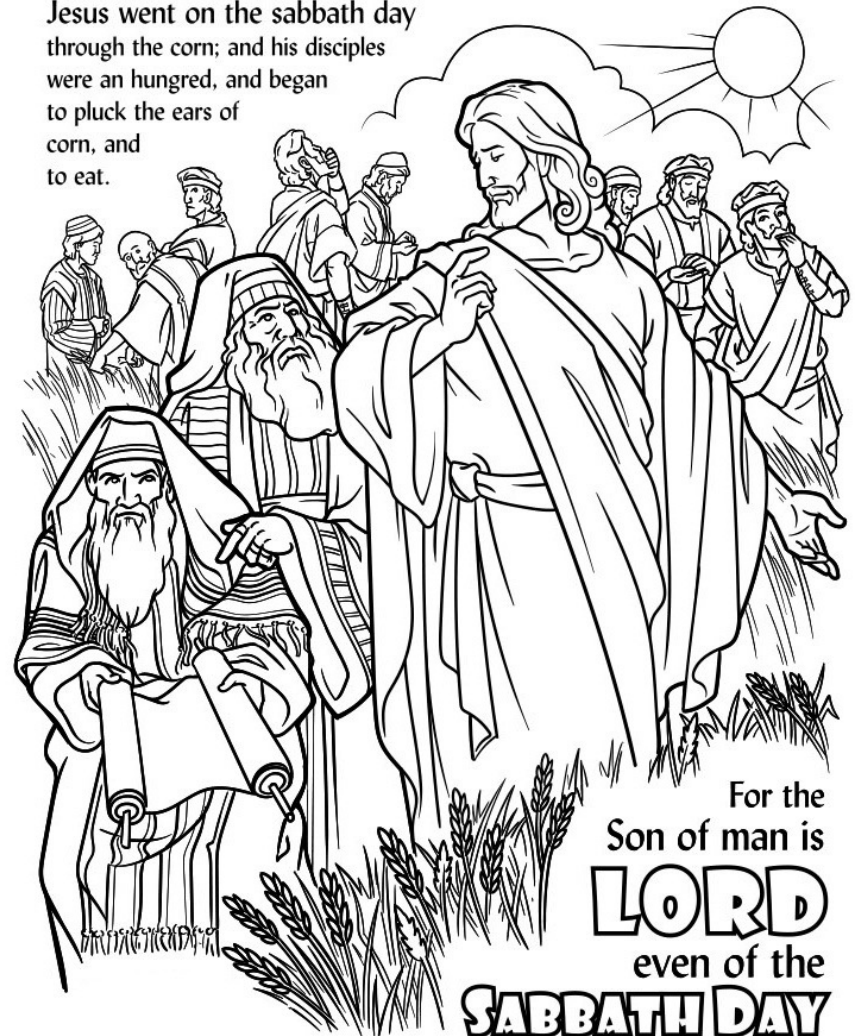
