# THE LANGUAGE OF GOD

Feast of Pentecost I Gospel Reading: Acts 2:1-21; John 14:25-31

In the book of Genesis, the people of the world try to build a to make a name for themselves, through pride (Gen. 11:1-9). This tower is called the Tower of Babel. When God saw what the people were doing, He struck them down and divided them into different nations with different languages, so that they would not be able to work together again.

Many thousands of years later, on the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came down upon the holy apostles and gave them the ability to speak many languages. Solving the problem of communication created at the Tower of Babel. Language was and is no longer something that divides people, but now, through the Holy Spirit, everyone is united together.

But as we see today there are still many languages which divide people and cause confusion when communicating with each other. Even in our churches, we hear languages like English, Armenian, Russian, Turkish, Arabic, and many other languages. So what language should we speak to unite everyone? What is the language that God speaks that we must also speak?

The only language that we should speak in the Church, and with each other, is the language of love. Love transcends languages, cultures, borders, and obstacles. 
