The presence of **Moses** and **Elijah** is of great significance for the understanding and celebration of the Feast of the Transfiguration. Moses and Elijah, according to the liturgical verses, are not only the greatest figures of the Old Testament who now come to worship the Son of God in glory, but these two figures actually stand for the Old Testament itself: **Moses for the Law and Elijah for the Prophets.** And Christ is the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets [Mt 5:17].

FINDING YOUR MOUNTAIN Feast of the Transfiguration | Matthew 16:13-17:13

The Feast of the Transfiguration is when Christ, with three of His disciples, went up Mount Tabor, and He was transfigured. That is to say, His power, divinity and glory was revealed to His disciples.

Along with Christ appeared the prophets Moses and Elijah, speaking with Him; Moses representing the Law and Elijah representing the prophets. Their appearance testified to Jesus being the fulfillment of the Law and the prophets. During this event, Peter wanted to stay, but Jesus told them they had to go back down.

Many times in the Old Testament and even in our Armenian history, we see the importance of mountains. Mankind has long understood that we come in contact with God on mountains and there were even times when men would create mountains in order to obtain or try to control God or the gods. Such examples are pyramids and the Tower of Babel.

Not everyone came go up a mountain to see God. So the question is: where do we come in contact with God?

Thankfully, we do not need to climb a mountain to find God, but can experience Him in the Holy Badarak. We hear His words and taste His precious Body and Blood. It is through Holy Communion that we meet God in His physical presence.

It is in this holy sanctuary that heaven and earth become one, and we join the disciples, in witnessing Christ's divine nature. We become participants in His divinity and express thanksgiving for His many blessings.

How often do you go to the holy mountain (Badarak) to see God?

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
