

# *Sending Mom* **S'more Love!**

**Proverbs 31:29**

*"Many women have done excellently, but you surpass them all."*

The word "S'more" is a combining of the words "some" and "more," because whenever you eat one, you want some more! God is good and when we experience His goodness, we will always want some more. And like our mother's love, His love is endless!



Your students will enjoy making a S'more package to give to their mom, and another to enjoy in class!

**LESSON:** There are 3 parts to a S'more, just like there are 3 parts to the Holy Trinity. Let's see how the parts of the S'more are like the Holy Trinity:

1. **Graham Cracker: GOD**, the Father. Like God, the graham cracker is the part that holds everything together and surrounds all.
2. **Chocolate: JESUS**, the Son. Like the chocolate, Jesus' love is sweet.
3. **Marshmallow: HOLY SPIRIT**. The marshmallow is the stickiest part of the S'more. When life gets "sticky" we know the Holy Spirit is always with us.

## **MATERIALS:**

- Large marshmallows
- Chocolate bar (break into sections) or Hershey Kisses
- Graham crackers
- Baggies or clear cello wrap
- Ribbon or yarn
- Template (*to follow*)

## **PREPARATION:**

- **For younger students**, you may want to package the items ahead of time.
- Print copies of Template

## **DIRECTIONS:** (*Be sure hands are clean before handling food items!*)

1. Print a copy of Template for each student.
2. Begin by discussing the **LESSON** above and the parts of the S'more and how they relate to the Holy Trinity. As you share the **LESSON**, allow each child to make a small S'more for themselves to eat. (Place the chocolate on the graham cracker and a marshmallow on the chocolate. Serve on napkins or paper towels.)
3. Next, have child make a S'more package for Mom:  
Give each child a Graham Cracker square, chocolate, and marshmallow and have them stack as pictured above, place in baggie, tie with a ribbon, and attach a copy of Template.
