HOLY MATRIMONY

The Sacrament of Crowning Crowns

SCRIPTURES:

Matthew 19:6 "So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate."

MATERIALS:

- Crown Pattern – *copy on cardstock, if possible, otherwise use Construction paper*
- Cardstock or Construction paper
- Scissors
- Colored markers
- Stapler
- Gems or other decorative items
- *Glue (if using gems or other decorative items)*

PREPARATION:

- Print Template
- Younger Students: If using construction paper, trace the crown pattern onto colored paper and cut out.
- Make a sample

DIRECTIONS:

1. Print out the crown pattern onto Cardstock OR trace the pattern onto colored construction paper. Cut out.
2. Have students decorate their crowns by copying scriptures, using colored markers, gems, and any other decorative items you have provided.
3. "Size" the crown around students' heads and staple together.
