

Sunday School Craft

Setting up an Orderly Church

SCRIPTURES:

Titus 3:8 *"I desire that you insist on these things, so that those who have come to believe in God may be careful to devote themselves to good works; these things are excellent and profitable to everyone."*

MATERIALS:

- Templates (to follow)
- Paper
- Colored markers or crayons
- Glue, glue dots, or tape
- Scissors

PREPARATION:

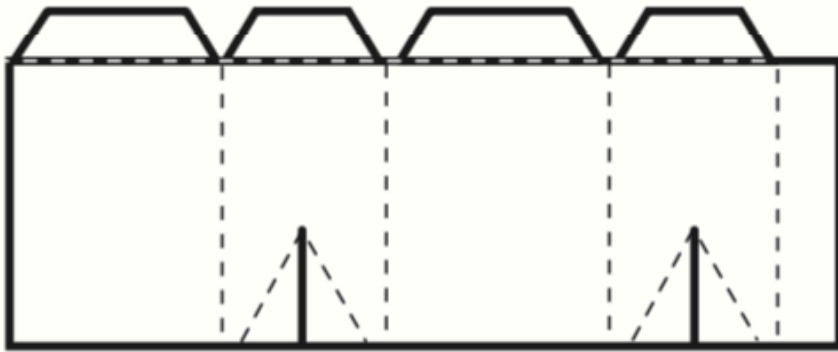
- Print Templates – *heavier paper works best* (cut out for younger students)
- Make a sample

DIRECTIONS:

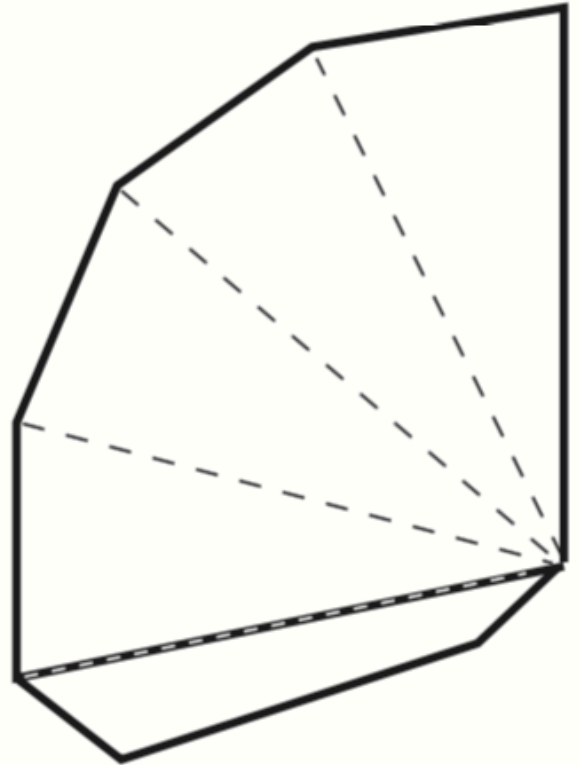
1. Print out steeple and roof patterns and the bottom of the church onto legal-sized paper - white card stock works best, if possible. Cut on the solid lines only.
2. Color the windows to look like they are "stained glass."
3. Color the church and steeple.
4. Fold all the dotted lines on the patterns back except the bottom part of the church with the words.
5. Glue (or tape) the bottom of the church together. Fold the roof pattern in half and glue (or tape) it to the top of the church pattern.
6. To make the bottom of the steeple fold all the dotted lines back and glue (or tape) it together to form a square. Glue (or tape) it to the roof on the triangle shapes formed by folding back the triangle tabs.
7. To make the top of the steeple fold back on all the dotted lines. Glue (or tape) it together and glue (or tape) it to the bottom of the steeple.



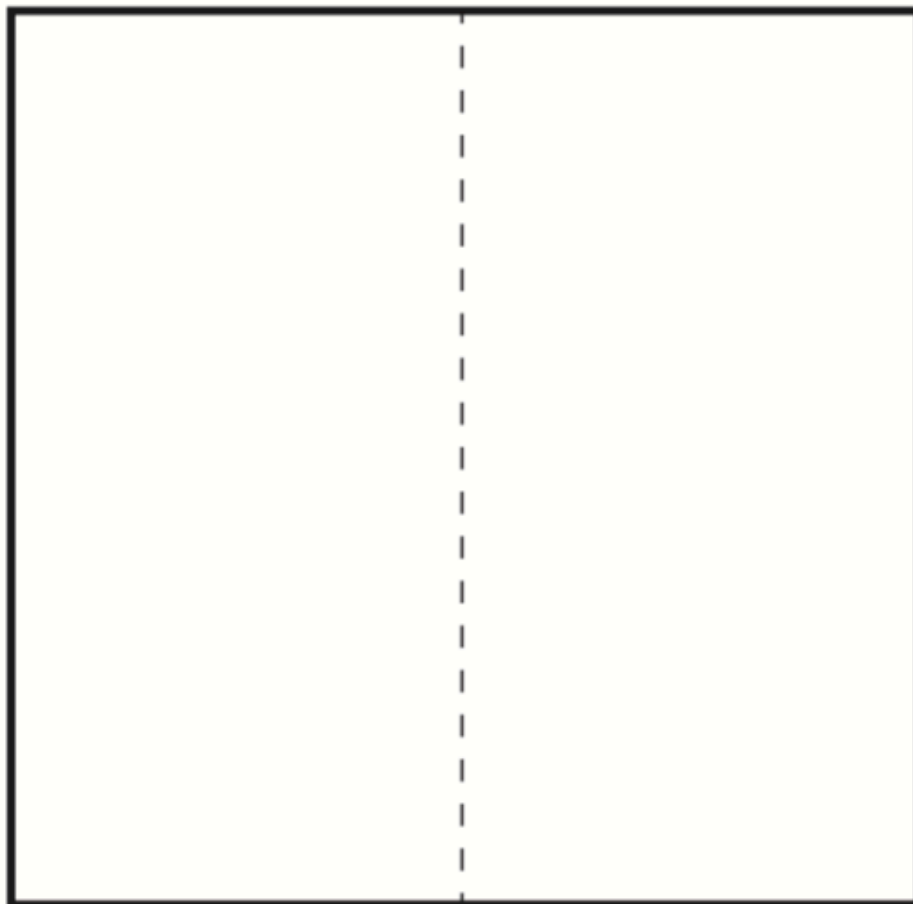
Bottom of Steeple
