Tower of Babel Crafty Snack

Genesis 11:1-9

Now the whole world had one language and a common speech.

Review the story of the Tower of Babel as told in Genesis 11:1-9.

Your students will enjoy stacking crackers to make their own Tower of Babel.



INGREDIENTS/MATERIALS:

- Your favorite crackers (graham crackers, Wheat Thins, Ritz, etc.)
- Spreadable cheese, honey, peanut butter (check for allergies), etc.
- Plastic knives
- Small paper plates

INSTRUCTIONS:

Before you begin, scoop the spreadable cheese, honey, or peanut butter onto a few paper plates so that students can reach easily.

1. Give each child a small paper plate. Around the edge of the plate, have them copy:

TOWER OF BABEL Genesis 11:1-9 "Now the whole world had one language and a common speech."

2. Give each child 5-10 crackers and a plastic knife. Allow them to spread a small amount on each cracker and stack to make a tower.
