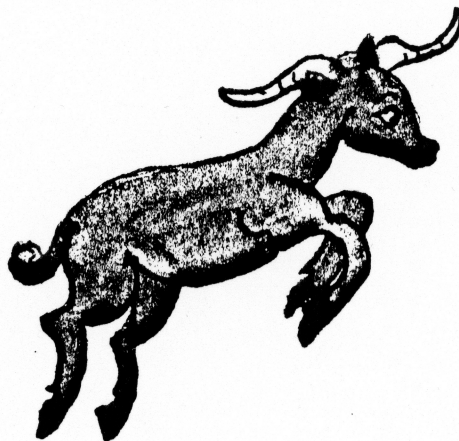


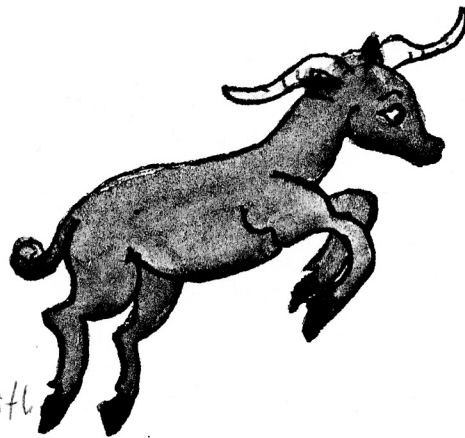

- 7□ Shoorchar = Cape / last vestment
