EASTER-CROSS GARDEN

Give each student in your Sunday School two wooden paint-stirring sticks. Then have them, or an adult who can help them, hot glue the sticks to create a cross. After telling the Easter story, have students each use a permanent marker to write on their cross what the resurrection means to them. Finally take the children out to your church's front yard and have them press the crosses into the dirt to create a garden of crosses. This is a wonderful surprise gift to your congregation in remembrance of Christ's resurrection.
