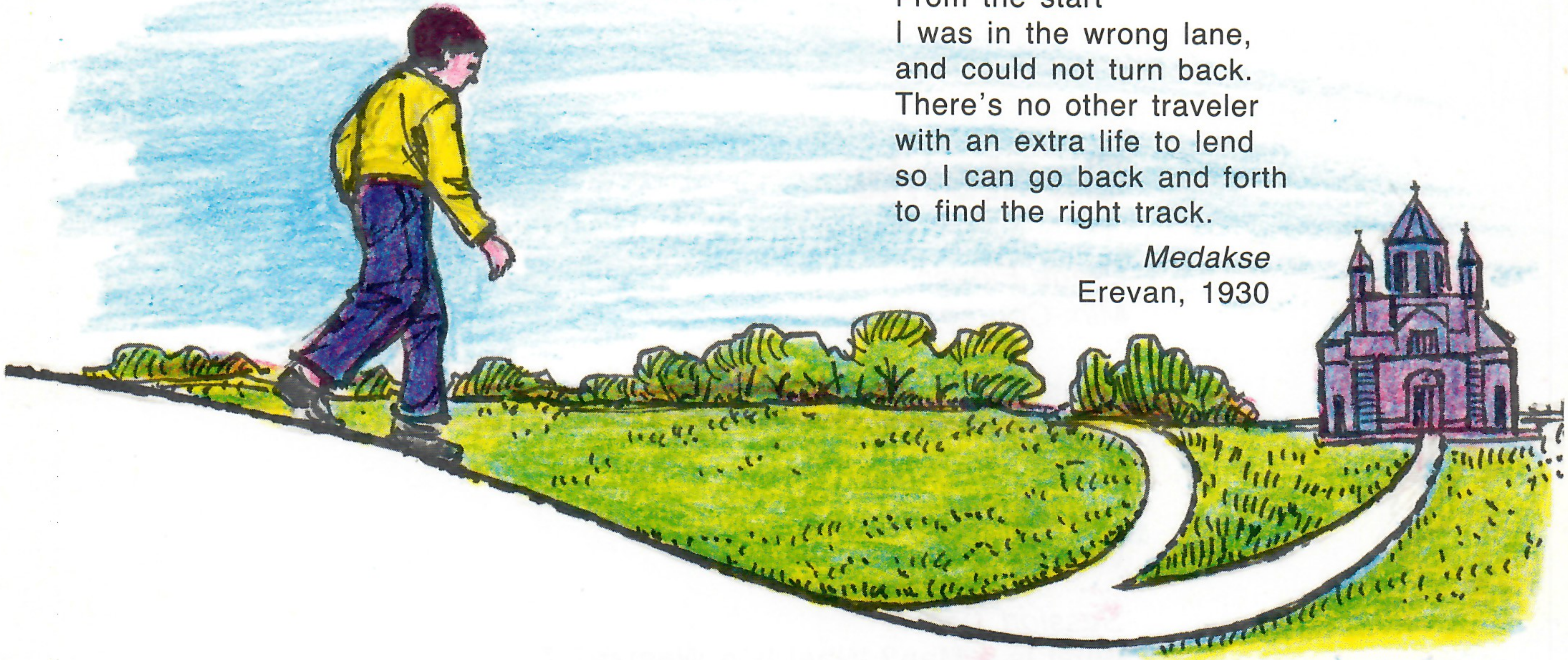


WHO AM I?

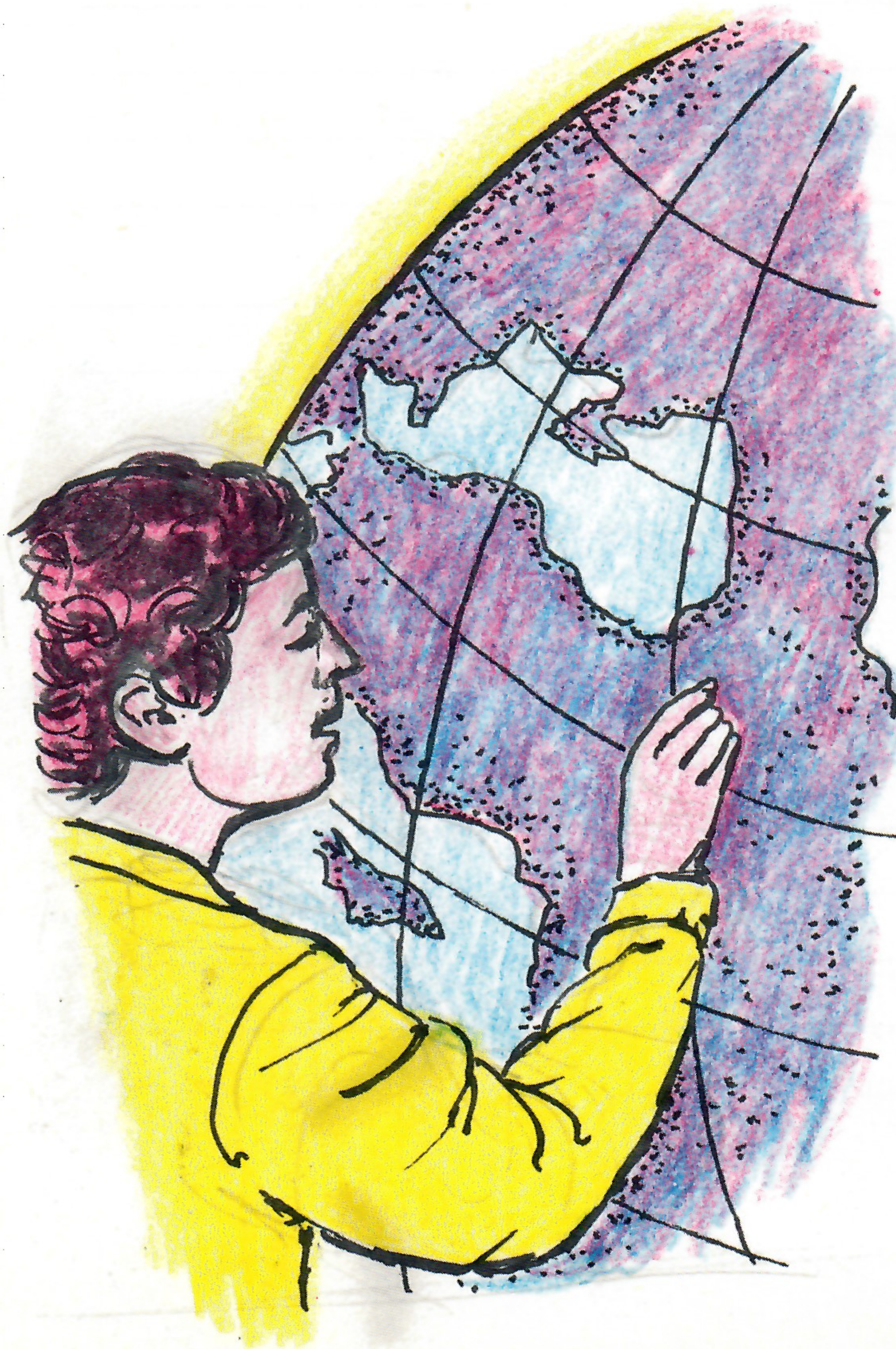
